## LEAGUE RULES, SCHEDULING, ETC

Thank you for participating in the 2014 Bardascino Park Bocce Club season. This year, Tim Stengel and Jon Leshar are sharing the administrative duties. We will be setting up the schedule, collecting fees, arranging referees, and setting up the playoff tournament. We are here to make this season as enjoyable as possible and will work to have everything go smoothly. We're all here to have fun! The following is a guide for everything you need to know to participate in this year's season.

### The season:

- Sign-ups will be Saturday, May 10<sup>th</sup> from 1PM to 3PM in Bardascino Park or, in the event of bad weather, we will find an indoor venue. If you are unavailable on May 10<sup>th</sup>, please email Tim and Jon at the email addresses listed below, and we will make alternative arrangements. No applications will be accepted after May 12<sup>th</sup>.
- The cost of the league is \$30 per team. Please pay in cash. The proceeds from the league dues go towards the end-of-season party, prizes, and the remainder is contributed to the Friends of Bardascino Park for upkeep of the park.
- We will email everyone on or around May 19<sup>th</sup> with the complete schedule, and we will also post the schedule on the Friends of Bardascino Park website and Facebook page.
- We hope to have the first game on Sunday, June 1<sup>st</sup> and have regular season games up to Labor Day. Teams will play four games in the season, and we will try to space them out as evenly as possible.
- Games will be played at 6PM on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays, and on Sundays, we will have two games at 4PM and 6PM. At least one of the Sunday games will be a regularly scheduled game, and we hope to use the other Sunday time slot for make-ups.
- The sign-up sheet includes spaces for preferred days/dates on which your team will play. We will attempt to accommodate any requests in creating the schedule. However, with the large number of teams we expect, we can make no promises. After the schedule is posted, if you notice you are scheduled on a date that does not work for you, please let us know as soon as possible.
- The playoff tournament will be held on a Saturday in September. The exact date will be determined toward the end of the season, but teams with a .500 record or better will make the playoffs.

Rainouts, cancellations, forfeits:

- Tim and Jon will make the call on rainouts and other cancellations as soon as possible. If we have to cancel a game, we will contact the teams who are scheduled to play via email/phone/text message. We will be in charge of rescheduling, and although the next available Sunday slot will be the default make-up date, we will work with the teams to find the best date.

- If your team cannot make a game, you need to let us know at least **24 HOURS before the game**. It's not fair to your opponents, or the refs, to have them show up and not have anything to do. If you do not notify us in time, you will forfeit the game.
